16th June that
they had advised Herries & Co to
pay it to C. Livingstone
in London. He
still wants it
paid to his wife
in America

Will you forward the enclosed to
your Bankers

I have manuscript
which I shall either
bring [to you] or send to
1 Robert St. Adelphi
tomorrow. I think
two or three more
than what I bring
tomorrow will
be the end. I am
going down the Zambesi
to Tete now

I shall bring M^{rs} L
to Sir Henry Holland
the first time I come
Will you send to
M^r Taylor¹ Robert
St. Adelphi if
I do not come
before 3 oclock
I shall bring
Kane.
