Dear transcription team,

Adrian and I are thrilled to say a huge THANK YOU for completing the proofing and transcription of all that we set out to accomplish for LEAP. This means that, in the 2 years and 2 months that we've been transcribing, we've managed to transcribe and encode a total of 2,302 pages. Here's a breakdown:

Total Field Diary pages (12 Field Diaries): 1,482

Total Unyanyembe Journal pages: 769

Total DLC letter pages (13 letters): 51

In our encoding, we also identified a huge number of distinct items:

term: 2618

persName: 2104

date: 1862

geogName: 1656

settlement: 1126

orgName: 979

In addition, each tag was used the following number of times:

term: 9252

persName: 5824

date: 5094

geogName: 3913

settlement: 2429

orgName: 3376

I've also attached the extracted lists of the six tags above. These haven't been proofed so there are a few errors, but they give you a sense of the breadth of the work of the work that we've done.

Thank you so much for joining me on these (sometimes seemingly endless!) rounds of transcription and proofing. Adrian and I are so proud of what our project has accomplished thanks to you. This is an amazing resource that will soon be freely available for everyone.
